# UPCOMING DATES & DEADLINES

- Established Party Filing: **November 25<sup>th</sup> – December 2<sup>nd</sup>**
  - Objection Filing Deadline: December 9<sup>th</sup>
- Applications for Vote by Mail ballots: **December 9<sup>th</sup>**
  - Send via email to [CWrigley@elections.il.gov](mailto:CWrigley@elections.il.gov)
- Presidential & Delegate Filing: **January 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>**
  - Objection Filing Deadline: January 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Ballot Certification: **January 9<sup>th</sup>**
- Note: Presidential & Delegate objection filing goes beyond this date.



VERIFICATION FILE SUBMISSION DEADLINE: MARCH 3, 2020  
DATA FILE SUBMISSION DEADLINE: APRIL 7, 2020

- Illinois eCanvass Instructions Manual will come out closer to date with more information and details.
- *Data file submissions now have to be uploaded through the ICN.*
- If your vendor uploads your file, they either have to do so locally or you will have to upload the file yourself.

# SB 2090 REQUIREMENTS

- A county jail is required to provide a registration application to any person who requests an application and is eligible to vote.
- The election authority should collaborate with the county jail to:
  - Facilitate an opportunity for voting by mail for voters eligible who are confined or detained;
  - Facilitate voter registration for voters eligible to vote.
- Upon discharge, the county jail shall provide individuals with a voter registration application and information regarding the individuals voting rights.
